

HARRISON OHIO CITY COUNCIL

MEETING MINUTES

17 JANUARY 2023

Prior to roll call, a Public Hearing on Changes to the Zoning Code was held, the Pledge of Allegiance was said, and Pastor Mark Garrett of Legacy Christian Church offered the invocation.

The meeting opened with Roll Call at 7:36pm.

Council met in regular session with Mayor Bill Neyer presiding. Members present included: Ms. Lexis Dole, Mr. Tony Egner, Mr. Ryan Grubbs, Mr. Mike Mains, Mr. Ryan Samuels, Mrs. Jean Wilson and Mr. Jerry Wilson.

Mr. Grubbs made a motion, seconded by Mr. Samuels, to approve the Council Meeting minutes from January 3, 2023. **Roll Call: All – yea.**

Shannon Hamons introduced Bob Greiwe of DWA Recreations, who spoke about his business as he was the Greater Harrison Chamber of Commerce January Member of the Month.

Mr. and Mrs. Wilson, representing American Legion Post 199, presented Mayor Neyer with a check for \$2284.20 for the Mayor's Community Fund.

Business

Mr. Grubbs made a motion, seconded by Mr. Egner, to approve a Resolution Accepting Annexation of Certain Land to the City of Harrison, Ohio from Harrison Township–Weisbrodt Property. **Roll Call: All – yea. (Resolution #1-23)**

Mr. Wilson made a motion, seconded by Mr. Grubbs, to approve as Amended (see following vote) an Ordinance Amending Part 11 of the City of Harrison's Codified Ordinances and the Zoning Code Map. **Roll Call: Grubbs, Samuels, Dole, Wilson, Wilson, Egner – yea, Mains-nay. (Ordinance #1-23)**

Mr. Grubbs made a motion, seconded by Mr. Samuels to amend various parts of the zoning changes presented tonight. The amendments were 1) Section 1167.06 remove addition of vegetable gardens permitted only in rear yards 2) Section 1143.06 add to the Conditional Use List stores with primary business of vape or smoke shop 3) Section 1143.06 add auto supply shops to #4 of Conditional Uses from #18 of Permitted Uses 4) Section 1167.09 E add the word Parking before the word Lot 5) Section 1167.06 typo correction. **Roll Call: All – yea.**
