

HARRISON OHIO CITY COUNCIL

MEETING MINUTES

03 MAY 2023

Prior to roll call, a Public Hearing for a Zoning Change for Oakland Hills Development was held, the Pledge of Allegiance was said and Mike Mains offered the invocation.

The meeting opened with Roll Call at 8:15pm.

Council met in regular session with Mayor Bill Neyer presiding. Members present included: Ms. Lexis Dole, Mr. Anthony Egner, Mr. Ryan Grubbs, Mr. Mike Mains, Mr. Ryan Samuels, Mrs. Jean Wilson and Mr. Jerry Wilson.

Mr. Grubbs made a motion, seconded by Mr. Egner, to approve the Council Meeting minutes from April 18, 2023. **Roll Call: Egner, Samuels, Dole, Mains, Mrs. Wilson, Mr. Wilson – yea. Grubbs – abstain (not present at meeting).**

Grubbs - abstain.**

Mr. Samuels made a motion to appoint Kim Downey, Finance Director, to be Harrison's RITA Council of Government Delegate and Ryan Samuels to be Alternate Delegate. Motion seconded by Mr. Egner. **Roll Call: All – yea.**

Mr. Wilson made a motion to participate in the RITA Non-filing Delinquency Letter Program. Motion seconded by Mr. Grubbs. **Roll Call: All – yea.**

Mr. Grubbs made a motion, seconded by Mr. Samuels, to approve an Ordinance Amending the Amount Appropriated to Various Funds of the City of Harrison Ohio. **Roll Call: All – yea. (Ordinance #7-23)**

Mr. Grubbs made a motion, seconded by Mr. Samuels, to approve a Resolution to Approve a Bid for the Edgewood Road Lift Station and Sanitary Sewer. **Roll Call: All – yea. (Resolution #5-23)**
