

Peddler/Vender/Itinerant Merchant Information for Applicants

The business of peddler, vendor or itinerant merchant is regulated by Chapter 731 of the City of Harrison code of Ordinances. Failure to comply with any provision of this Chapter may be cause for denial or revocation of your registration.

The registration fees required, set forth in Section 731.02 of the Harrison Code of Ordinances, are:

\$25.00 per day, for **each** applicant.

Peddlers, vendors and itinerant merchants are prohibited from doing any of the following:

Engaging in their business before 9:00 A.M. or after 9:00 P.M. Eastern Standard Time

Operating in or on any City owned property or in a zone where such activity is prohibited.

Harass, vex or annoy any person, or enter into a residence without permission of the resident.

Knock at the door, or ring the bell of any private home, apartment or apartment building where a sign has been posted stating "No Peddlers" or words to that effect, unless invited by the owner, lessee or occupant thereof.

Call attention to sales by calling out, or by use of any sound producing and/or amplifying device.

At all times while engaged in their business, peddlers, vendors and itinerant merchants must have in their possession their permit of registration and exhibit same to any person solicited, or on request of any Police Officer.
