Please submit your application to recommission@harrisonohio.gov no later than **Thursday, June 23, 2022**. Email submission of your parade application is the preferred method. Applications can be dropped off with the receptionist at the Community Center.

Staging Number – You will be notified via e-mail prior to the parade. Some parade units will assemble directly on Broadway; those units will be notified by a parade organizer. Unit number and staging locations are subject to change so please be flexible. Parade organizers will be at the Community Center to help direct you to your spot.

Staging Times: 3:00 pm – 3:45 pm. Please arrive during this time to allow for staging of the parade line up. Do not check-in at the last minute or after the parade begins. Organizing multiple parade entrants and participants can take time to ensure a well-organized and successful parade for our community.

Day of the Parade – No vehicles will be permitted to enter George Street

All Parade Units - Please enter the Community Center from the Etta Avenue entrance.

Take Broadway to South Elm Street. Turn onto South Elm Street (it only turns one way). Then turn left onto Etta Avenue which will take you into the Community Center. You will be greeted by a volunteer who will check you in and confirm your unit number.

Parade Participants - If you are dropping someone off for the parade, please drop them off at the intersection of George Street and Broadway.

Parking for Parade Participants –There is limited parking behind the Community Center, as well as on-street parking.

Parade Route – The parade begins at the Harrison Community Center at George Street and Broadway. We will proceed west on Broadway to State Street, north one block to Harrison Avenue, then proceed east on Harrison to Washington. That is the official end of the parade. Most participants will then continue south on Washington to Broadway, east on Broadway to George and return to the Community Center.

Candy or giveaways – candy and giveaways may be passed out by parade participants, but should not be thrown at the parade spectators.
